BMSDC Tree planting near the Village Hall

On 26th November BMSDC delivered 80 hedging plants and 12 trees to the home of GG Chair, Lesli Tunbridge, along with posts, tree ties and guards.

<u>Hedging</u>: 50 Hawthorn; 10 Hazel; 5 each of Field Maple, Spindle, Dog Rose and Hornbeam.

<u>Trees</u>: 1 Silver Birch; 3 Field Maple; 3 Rowan; 2 Cherry; 1 Crab Apple; 2 Hornbeam.



A working party of six Greening Glemsford members planted the hedging on Sunday 5th December, on the strip of land along the top edge of the Village Hall carpark.

All but two of the trees were planted the following Sunday (12th) along the top and side edges of the Village Hall overflow carpark.

The potential size of the two Hornbeam trees were considered too large for the plot, so they will be planted at the Cemetery, where one will replace the recently removed Cherry tree.
