





# BABERGH DISTRICT Report To Glemsford Parish Council For PCM 12/02/2013

This report covers the period from **08/01/13** to **11/02/13**. During this time there has been **9** crimes recorded within the parish, this compares to **2** crimes for the same period last year.

# **BREAKDOWN OF CRIME**

### **#Burglary Other Building**

- Between 1700 and 1800 on 14/01/13 suspects unknown have broken into a garage on Angel Lane. Nothing stolen. This crime has since been finalised. SU/13/128 Pc 1424 Shelley
- At 1740 on 14/01/13 suspect unknown broke into a garden shed on Angel Lane. Nothing stolen. This crime has since been finalised. SU/13/131 Pc 1635 Moore
- At 1745 on 14/01/13 suspects unknown broke in to the social club on Hunts Hill. Items were stolen. This crime has since been finalised. SU/13/133 Pc 1263 Battershall

Crimes recorded within the Parish of Glemsford have increased from the same period last year. Five of these crimes are burglary other building and no houses on these occasions were entered. Three out of the five are believed to have been committed by the same suspects at the same period of time. However Crime across Suffolk is reducing, please be assured that Suffolk Police are continuing to target those individuals who are involved in burglary's within our communities.

You can help us reduce crime further and protect your home by following these simple steps:

- Ensure all doors and windows are closed when leaving your property.
- Lock doors and windows even if popping out for a few minutes
- Remove tools/objects i.e. bricks and garden tools from the garden as these could be used to force entry.
- Lock rear gates and sheds with a good quality padlock.
- Use lights/radio on timers when you are out
- Use dusk to dawn lighting around your home
- Leaving your home unlocked all in darkness and with valuables all on view could mean that you end up giving burglars a gift.
- Call police if you see or hear anything suspicious.

Please remember many burglaries occur because a thief sees the opportunity of a window left open or a door unlocked.

On Friday 8<sup>th</sup> February a police crime reduction surgery was held at Glemsford village hall for all to visit. This proved successful and arrangements will be made for another surgery to take place.
